Both free roam activities (trader resupply, sales, strangers, bounties, hideouts, free roam events, etc.) and instanced activities (story, moonshiner story, showdowns, etc.) can be done co-op. When you are both in the same posse (temporary and permanent both work) and the posse leader chooses to to start an activity, all posse members join. You said you invited each other, but did you accept the invite afterwards? On PC, after receiving an invite, you can hold F1 to view and accept it. Otherwise, you can open your player menu to be "Open" instead of "invite only". The other player can then find your posse in the player menu join it. How Posses work in Red Dead Online (hint: it's co-op) Posses are a way to join forces with other players and stay together — that's effectively what differentiates them from just inviting someone into your world. Posses always include a Posse Leader who sets up the Posse, but one kind of Posse is more, well, hardcore than the other. There are two types: Temporary Posses are free to set up, have a limit of four players and disappear when the Posse Leader guits. Think of them as a guick and easy way to get your friends together. After you're done with that, however, there's still the online mode to get into, and this allows you to play with friends. Here's how you can play missions with friends in Red Dead Online. Before you can start gallivanting around the wild west with your cowboy pals, you'll need to either create a posse that they can join, or just join one that your friend's already in. To create a posse, bring up your in-game menu by pressing left on the d-pad, then choose the Players option. From here, you can see a list of players who are currently in your lobby. Use the L1 and R1 buttons (or left and right bumpers if you're on Xbox One) to head over to your Friends tab. Choose the player on your friends list that you want to invite to your posse. It's as simple as that. It's worth noting that there are temporary ones are free to set up, while the permanent ones will cost you 200 in-game dollars. If you're just planning a casual play session with friends, the temporary option should work well enough for you. Once you've sent the posse invite to your friends, they'll have to accept it before you can be placed in the same lobby. When in a posse together, you and your friends will be able to do missions together and explore the world at your own leisure. All you have to do is head to the relevant mission marker to start it, and your friends will be able to join you on your quest. Players can leave the posse at any time by pressing left on the d-pad, and choosing to leave that first. And that's all you need to know about how to play missions with friends in Red Dead Online.
